Mr. Mike Rowse, played a major role in putting together the *Hong Kong Disney Theme Park* project, and was the first Commissioner for Tourism (May 1999-Aug. 2000) of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China. In July 2000 he was appointed as the first Director-General of Investment Promotion. He established the government's investment promotion agency – *Invest Hong Kong*, which provides free information, advice and support services and helps foreign and Mainland investors to take full advantage of the City's ever-expanding business potentials. In August 2001, he became the first expatriate civil servant in Hong Kong's history to naturalize as a Chinese National.
